Registration forms are available at the Muncie

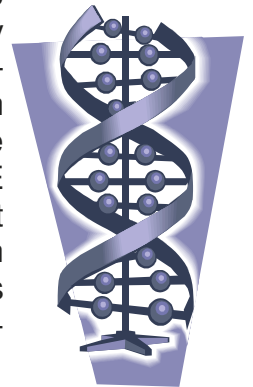
Public Library Connection Corner, 1824 E Centennial. Be sure to complete and return the form to the Connection Corner by 4PM, July 18th.

MEDICINE AND MEDIA

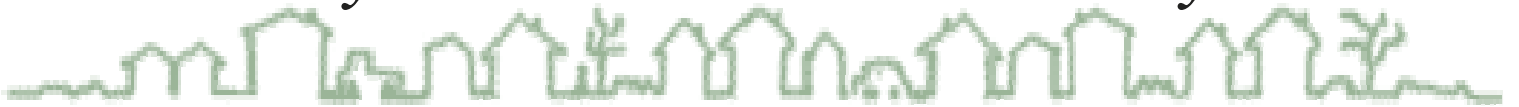
You are invited to join a community conversation, based upon the very popular book *The Immortal Life of Henrietta Lacks*, written by Rebecca Skloot.






- Limited criminal history check and TB test required.

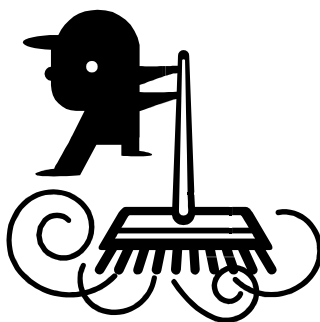
